General Instructions to the Candidates

Please read carefully and comply with all the instructions

- 1. Candidates will be allowed to appear in the examination only on producing E-Call letter, relieving cum Photo Identification letter duly signed by Controlling Officer in charge on the photograph, and original photo ID. Candidates are also advised to bring recent colour passport size Photograph (3.5 cm x 4.5 cm)
- 2. Candidature is Provisional. This E-Call letter does not, by itself, give any entitlement whatsoever for selection to any posts in any Zonal Railways/PUs.
- 3. Candidate must write Self declaration in running handwriting (not in block / capital letters) as it appears on candidate's console in the given space on the E-call letter in presence of the Invigilator.
- 4. Candidates to note the following timings. Candidates should report at the centre of the examination strictly at the time mentioned in the E-Call letter to complete activities such as verification, capture of photo, collection of documents, and announcement of instructions and logging in etc.,

- 5. No Candidate will be allowed to enter the Exam Centre after Gate closing time.
- 6. Candidates will be allowed to appear for CBAT only at the nominated Centre, on the date and time indicated in the E-Call Letter.
- 7. Request if any, for change of Examination Centre, date and time will not be entertained.
- 8. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall until the examination is over. Candidates must remain seated in their place till the end of the Examination.
- 9. The test will be conducted online (CBAT mode). Candidates must enter their Username (which will be the Candidate's Roll No.) and Password (which will be Candidate's DOB in DDMMYYYY format) to login 15 minutes before the Exam start time to read the assessment related instructions. Candidates may ensure that, Name and other details which will subsequently appear on the screen are correct.
- 10. Candidates need not bring stationary such as Pencils, Ballpoint Pen etc. with them. No Rough sheet is allowed in the exam.
- 11. Bags, Books, Notebooks, ornaments, Coins, Watch, Cards having chips, Calculators, Mobile phones, Pager, Headphones, buttonhole cameras, scanner storage devices, blue tooth and electronic gadgets etc. are strictly prohibited and banned inside the Examination Centre premises. Candidature will be cancelled/rejected on the spot even if any candidate is found with such item even in switch off or closed mode besides initiation of D&AR action. The Railway/examination centre shall not make any arrangement and is not responsible for the safe custody of any such item.
- 12. Candidate must surrender Railway foil of the E-Call letter to the invigilator and retain the candidate's copy which will be required at the time of document verification.
- 13. Candidates should strictly obey the instructions issued by the ECA/Railway Officials present at the Examination Centre/Hall.
- 14. RRC/SWR reserves the right to order cancellation/re-examination for any candidate or group of candidates and change Venue / Date of examination.
- 15. A specific computer node number will be allotted to every candidate.
- 16. Candidates must make their own arrangements for accommodation while coming for CBAT.
- 17. No Rough sheet & pencils will be provided to the candidates for rough work.
- 18. The candidate can view the question paper in English and Hindi language simultaneously. In case of any differences between English and Hindi language, question in English language shall prevail. If any candidate is found obstructing the conduct of the examination or creating disturbances at the examination venue, his/her candidature shall be summarily cancelled besides initiation of disciplinary proceedings. In case of walkout, for any reason whatsoever no re-examination will be taken.
- 19. Candidates are advised to refer to RRC/SWR website for guidelines regarding the examination, downloading E-Call letter cum Relieving and photo identification letter.

- 20. No supplementary exams will be conducted under any circumstances.
- 21. Candidates are advised to locate their test centre and its accessibility before the test so that they can reach the centre on time on the day of the test.
- 22. This E-Call letter is valid only for the test date, shift and time as specified thereon.
- 23. No bio-breaks will be provided during the duration of the CBAT exam. Candidates may note and be prepared accordingly.
- 24. Special instructions, if any, given by the Invigilator should be followed strictly.
